This year our panel of industry judges reviewed and discussed 65 projects located throughout the region, which comprises of Delaware, Maryland, Pennsylvania, Virginia, West Virginia and the District of Columbia.

Eight judges from across the industry—including architects, engineers, contractors and a public owner—were split up into two groups and assigned a group of categories. Projects were evaluated on the ability of the project team to overcome challenges, contribution to
